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**VENDOR INVITATION LETTER**

**RE: 8th American Indian Heritage Celebration**

The American Indian Community of Santa Clara County will be hosting our 8th American Indian Heritage Celebration in San Jose, California. The theme for this year's celebration is "Living Healthy". The celebration will take place on Saturday, September 12, 2015 from 12 pm to 10 pm at the Santa Clara County Fairgrounds (Pavilion Hall) located at 344 Tully Road, San Jose, CA 95111 (3.8 miles west of HWY 101 - 8 mins.).

This will be an all-day Celebration, Indian Market, Big Time, and a Powwow that will take us into the night. Many other events will be occurring throughout the day as well, including: American Indian arts and crafts vendors, community information and non-profit booths, a health fair, tribal information booths, and food booths. There will also be display boards with information on various Tribes and their respective languages, American Indian drumming and music, dance presentations, cultural crafts and activities, a kid's fun zone, and lots of great family fun.

The AIHC Committee would like to extend a formal invitation to you to attend as a vendor:

**Tribal Information Booths are free (10' x 20').** Two premium parking passes are included. You will also receive 4 tables and 4 chairs to use in your booth.

**Information/Non-Profit/Health Organizations are \$50 per booth (10' x 10').** One parking pass is included. You will also receive 1 table and 2 chairs to use in your booth.

**Arts and Crafts Vendor Booths are \$200 (10' x 10' space).** One premium parking pass is included. You will also receive 2 tables and 2 chairs to use in your booth.

**Arts and Crafts Vendor Booths are \$300 (10' x 20' space).** One premium parking pass is included. You will also receive 4 tables and 4 chairs to use in your booth.

**Food Booths are \$400 (Outside Pavilion Hall).** One premium parking pass is included.

**Corporate Booths are \$1,000 (10' x 20').** Two premium parking passes are included. You will also receive 4 tables and 4 chairs to use in your booth.

**Arts and Crafts Vendors must also provide:**

- Copy of a current California Seller's Permit (California State Board of Equalization 800-400-7115; <http://www.boe.ca.gov>)
- Four (4) close up photos of the items you will be selling
- Contribution of a sample of merchandise for our fund raiser raffle is required with a minimum retail **value of \$25**. *Please be sure to provide a detailed description of the item you will be contributing on the vendor form.*

**Deadline: August 3, 2015 - Absolute deadline. No late registration or walk-ins day of event. Sharing of booth space is not permitted.**

**Refund Policy -**

**By May 18, 2015 - 100% full refund**

**By June 22, 2015 - 75% refund**

**By July 20, 2015 - 50% refund**

**By August 2 - 25% refund**

**After August 3, 2015 - No refund**

**Please be advised that the Indian Arts and Craft Act of 1990 shall apply to all arts and crafts vendors. *The Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 (P.L. 101-644) is a truth-in-advertising law that prohibits misrepresentation in marketing of Indian arts and crafts products within the United States. It is illegal to offer or display for sale, or sell any art or craft product in a manner that falsely suggests it is Indian produced, an Indian product, or the product of a particular Indian or Indian Tribe or Indian arts and crafts organization, resident within the United States. Under the Act, an Indian is defined as a member of any Federally or State recognized Indian Tribe, or an individual certified as an Indian artisan by an Indian Tribe.***
